

For Adorers on an occasion they cannot come to adore for their hour:

Guidelines for Replacement :

1 / A gift

(!) To find a replacement for myself for adoration, might, at first glance, appear to me as a problem, a concern, an anguish ... a calamity (!) but yet, it's actually a gift:

A gift for me who has to transform myself into a missionary, an evangelizer, to propose this replacement to others around me.

A gift for those I ask because it is an opportunity for them to take stock with regard to their relationship with God.

A gift for those who accept because they will have an extraordinary experience of spending an hour face to face with Jesus, the Son of God.

So let us receive and give this gift with joy!



2 / Procedure for replacing oneself

1st Step (the most important): Try to replace oneself with a family member, a friend, a relative, a neighbor ... It takes courage, but it's a gift! One could also try co-workers, members of our sports or social club, parishioners not yet involved in adoration ...).

2nd Step (after the first if it really is unsuccessful): call the person who adores the same time as me (if any) to ensure their presence.

3rd Step (after the first two): Try to be replaced by someone (propose a swap) from my section (morning, afternoon, evening or night) or ask the adorer before or after me to do an extra hour ... and return the favour!

4th Step (if all else failed after the first three steps): call the leader of that division (not the priest nor the other division leaders). In general, this step must be very exceptional. The division leader will then take responsibility to find a replacement.

Each adorer is guardian of the Blessed Sacrament. He must not leave the chapel if there are no other adorers present. Please come on time and sign the weekly permanence sheet on entering the chapel.
